Our total annual commitment to missionaries: \$ 11,959.20

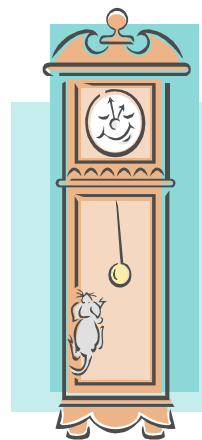
Faith Promise Checking Account Balance as of November 30, 2010 \$ 9,569.91

On Wednesday, February 9th during our evening services, Josh Mullins & family will join us to talk about their experiences and ministries as missionaries



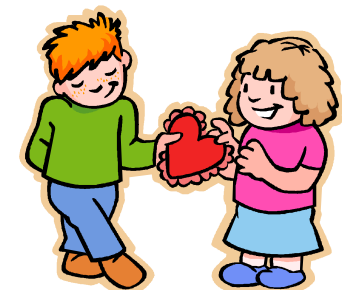

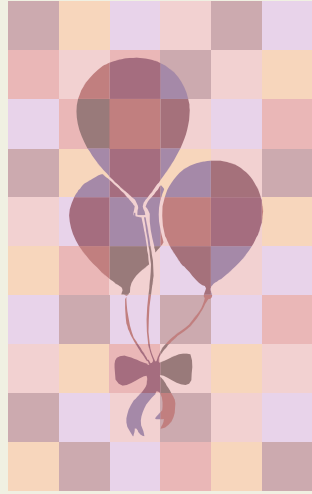
